

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following term of office of Director of the Upper Arkansas Water Conservancy District representing Division 5 “Seat A” (area encompassed by Fremont County School District RE-1) shall expire June 1, 2024.

Property owners having resided for one year in each of such divisions, respectively, may apply for appointment to the term of office commencing June 1, 2024, for a four year term expiring June 1, 2028. Any property owner eighteen years of age or older owning property within the Upper Arkansas Water Conservancy District and residing within the Division for which the appointment is sought is eligible for appointment to office.
